My name is Brother Raymond Pierce CSSR. I live in Toronto, at our Headquarters for English speaking Redemptorists' in Canada at 426 St Germain Ave., Toronto, ON M5M 1W7, Phone: 416 789 3217 Ext 249.

For over fifty years the Redemptorists' have had a Mission Fund Raiser, that involves collecting used postage stamps and selling them by the pound and sending the money to charities like the Canadian Food for Children Charity.

People are using the mail less now and as a result, we are receiving fewer stamps. We want to expand our used stamps donor base to ask more people to send us used stamps. So we would like to ask the various CWL Councils in Ontario, if they would join us in collecting used stamps and send them to us.

The current Director of our Redemptorist Stamp Burse, for the past fifty years, is Helen McCarthy

Helen will celebrate her 90th birthday this summer and plans to retire as Director of The Stamp Burse. Helen will pass on the Redemptorist Stamp Burse to Maureen Phylips of Mississauga, Ontario.

Over all these years Helen McCarthy's labor of love efforts have raised over

three thousand dollars annually, from the sale of used stamps. When Helen has a thousand dollars, in the Stamp Bourse Bank Account, she sends us a cheque for a thousand dollars which we match with another thousand dollars and we send two thousand dollars to The Canadian Food for Children Charity.
